

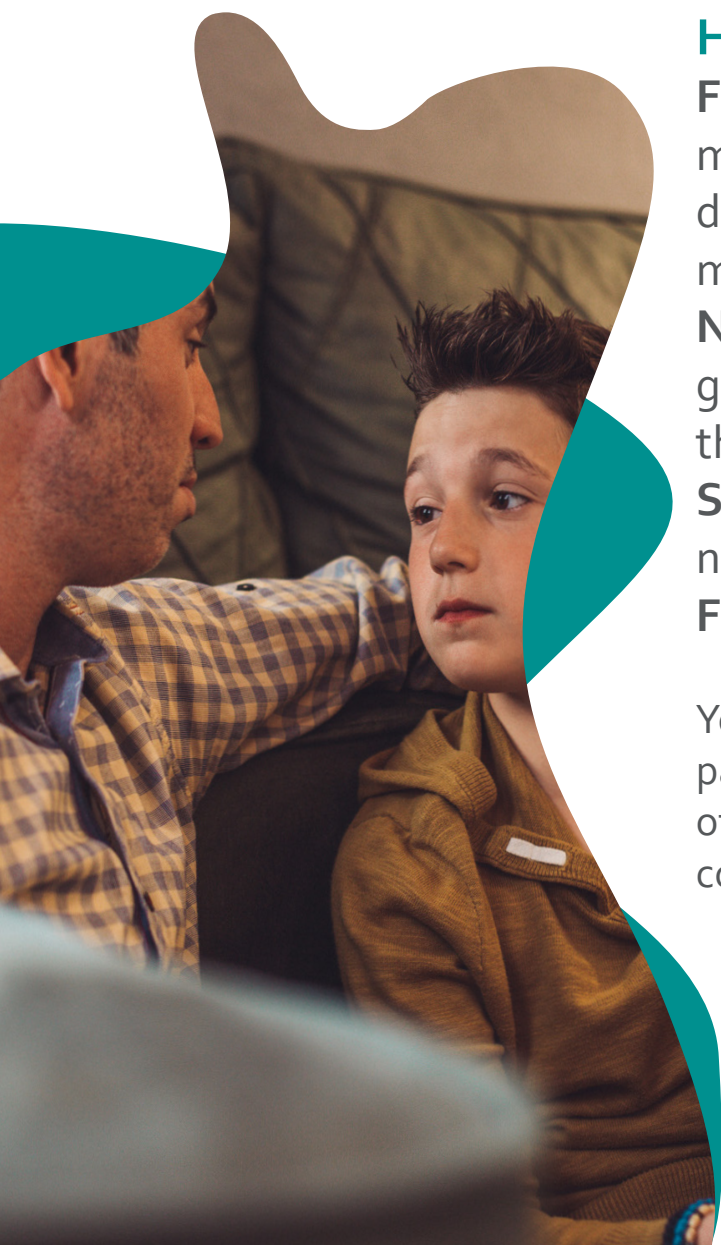


Respect Young People's Programme

Are you working with a family experiencing Child to Parent Violence and Abuse? Looking for an accredited intervention which can make a positive change? (Young person must be aged 8 to 18)

We can only accept requests from the following NCC Children's Services Professionals:

- Family Help Social Workers and Family Practitioners/New Roads/Fostering/Support for Success/Corporate Parenting Social Workers
- If appropriate, Children with Disabilities Social Workers



How to make a request

Family Help: talk to your intervention manager or discuss it with your linked domestic abuse worker in your allocation meeting
