Freedom of Information Request FOI/OPCCN/115

I am writing in connection with your email dated 6th February 2017, which also links to your earlier request FOI/OPCCN/114, in which you seek the following information:

- “1. What is the official policy of the PCC on their individual police forces FAILING to police illegal hunts properly and take appropriate action when informed of and presented with evidence of assault and intimidation?**
- 2. If the PCC does not hold the information requested in my original email, does it hold ANY information on ANY subject relating to the performance of their individual police forces? If so, could I please have details of the type of information held.**
- 3. An answer to question 5 of my original email please as this is a direct question to PCC policy”**

I have reviewed our records and I can advise the following:

In respect of Question 1, no information is held by the OPCCN.

Under Section 8(1)(c) of the Freedom of Information Act 2000, a request must describe the information requested. Question 2 above does not specify the exact information you are requesting and therefore is not considered a valid request under the Act. If you are dissatisfied in any way with our response or the way we have handled your request, you can contact us by phone, email or in writing. We may, in the first instance, try and resolve your complaint informally. However, at any stage you can request or we may decide to treat your complaint formally under our internal review process.

An internal review is conducted by the Chief Executive who will review the request and response, taking account of your complaint(s), and will respond in writing as soon as possible. The Information Commissioner's Officer recommends that a response should be made in 20 working days. If we are unable to respond in this timeframe we will inform you and provide a date by which you should expect to receive our response.
