SUMMARY:

It is proposed to relocate some existing PCC portakabins from Bowthorpe Police Station site to Wymondham OCC.

These are required to provide additional storage and training space for the Firearms Training Unit.

This report seeks PCC approval to submit a planning application for the siting of the portakabins at Wymondham OCC.

It is recommended that the PCC approves the submission of a planning application for the Wymondham OCC portakabins for firearms training unit.

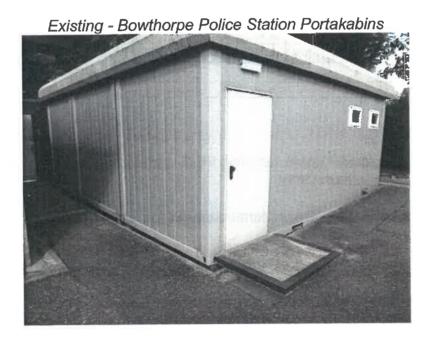

KEY ISSUES FOR CONSIDERATION

1. OVERVIEW:

- 1.1 The Firearms Training Unit based at Wymondham OCC has requested some additional operational storage and training space.
- 1.2 Following collaboration of firearms training services, the amount of officers and instructors has increased.
- 1.3 Originally the team had an Inspector, 1 Sergeant and 8 Firearms Instructors.
- 1.4 It now accommodates 1 Chief Inspector, 1 Inspector, 2 Sergeants, 17 Firearms Instructors, 1 Armourer and 2 administrators.
- 1.5 It is proposed to provide this space next to an existing Firearms Training Unit modular building in the rear car parking at Wymondham OCC and re-use an existing portakabin building from Bowthorpe Police Station to provide the premises.



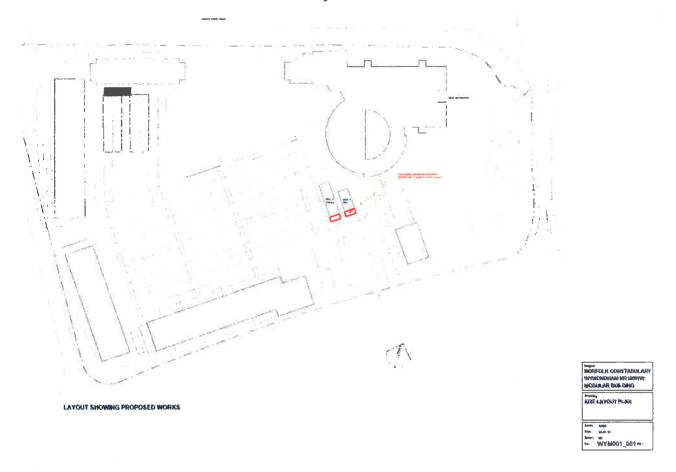
- 1.6 The estimated cost to provide the new storage facility is as follows:
 - Ground works by Panache Builders: £ 4,164
 - > Porta-cabins move and build by Anglo Scottish:£ 4,000
 - ➤ Electrics fit out and connections estimate: £ 1,000
 - Security works estimate: $\underbrace{£ 1,000}_{\textbf{£10,164}}$

1.7 This paper seeks the PCC's approval to submit a planning application for the siting of the portakabins on the Wymondham OCC site from South Norfolk Council.

1.8 As the portakabin structures are of a temporary nature, any planning permission is likely to be granted for a period of 5 years.

1.9 The site location is as shown red on the below plan.

2. STRATEGIC AIMS/OBJECTIVE SUPPORTED:

2.1 The recommendation supports the PCC's Police and Crime Plan 2016-2020 by delivering a modern and innovative service and good stewardship of tax payer's money.

3. FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS:

3.1 REVENUE:

The estimated running costs are £800 per annum for business rates, background heating and electric.

No additional sums are requested for the Estates Department base budget.

3.2 CAPITAL:

The fit out cost of £10,164 is planned to be funded from the existing Estates Department minor works budget. No additional monies are requested.
