#### SUMMARY:

The Police and Crime Commissioner has elected to continue using his personal mobile to carry out official business calls as opposed to being provided with a new mobile/Blackberry unit, which would be supported and paid for from within existing budgets.

With this in mind and given the number of calls undertaken, the Chief Executive, under delegated decisions, taking into account the 'Exceptional Expenses' section of the PCC Travel and Subsistence Scheme, and in conjunction with the Chief Finance Officer, has agreed to the payment of a monthly telephone allowance to the PCC of £25, commensurate with approximately a 1/3<sup>rd</sup> of the PCC's monthly call costs.

## RECOMMENDATION:

- That the PCC be paid a telephone allowance of £25 per month, with effect from 1<sup>st</sup> April 2013.
- 2. That the PCC Travel and Subsistence Scheme be amended to reflect 1.
