

 25% decrease from the previous year (934 in 2016/17 to 700 in 2017/18), with a four year downward trend.

Crime levels have remained relatively static (2.2% increase from previous year).

The largest increase is for Sexual Offences (21%, compared to a Force increase of 14%).

The total increase for all crimes is 2.2% (in comparison to a national increase of 6%\*). Certain crime type rises may be due to increases in police pro-active work.

- Drugs offences have increased since the previous year (121 from 104), but this is more likely due to police activity than an actual increase in these crime types. Positive outcomes for possession and supply of drugs have decreased since the previous year.
- Over the two year period there were 52 recorded instances of a person arrested and taken into custody where 'weapon' was tagged as a keyword on the offence record. However, actual figures for weapon offences remain low (13).
- There have been 446 incidents recorded as a 'missing person' between 01/11/2017 and 31/10/2018. However, 62 individual people were reported missing on repeat occasions accounting for 214 incidents.
